## ADVERTISEMENT FOR ADMISSION INTO LASU FOUNDATION PROGRAMME FOR 2009/2010 ACADEMIC SESSION

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for admission into the Lagos State University Foundation Programme which shall commence in September, 2009.

The Programme shall run for 12 calendar months beginning from September, 2009 to August, 2010. It is an intensive programme to prepare exceptionally brilliant candidates for admission into the 200 level degree programmes offered by the University.

The Programme is located in the Lagos State University, Foundation Programme Campus, ASCON Road, Topo Badagry.

### Admission Requirements

- Five (5) Ordinary Level credit passes in relevant subjects, including English Language. For candidates pursuing courses in Science, Science Education, Social Sciences, Management Sciences and Engineering, credit pass in Mathematics is compulsory. Credit pass in Literature in English is compulsory for Law.
- Students who meet the admission requirements will be invited for a written qualifying examination.
- Successful candidates will be required to pay a non-refundable acceptance fee of ₦10, 000.

### Criteria for Transiting to 200 Level

- At the end of the Foundation Programme, in order to qualify for direct entry admission to 200 Level of the Programme, a student must have scored a minimum Average of 2.50
- Successful candidates that will be enrolled in the degree programmes at the 200 level must purchase the Direct Entry JAMB form.
- Students who failed may be allowed to repeat the programme.
- On admission, if any student voluntarily withdraws from the Programme, request for refund of school fee can only be made by such student **before** the end of First Term of the Calendar Year. Any request made after that period will **NOT** be entertained.

iv) Candidate should, thereafter, submit the hard copy of the application form (as printed online) and an original copy of the bank teller to the Office of the Secretary, LASU Foundation Programme Annex, opposite the Law Library, Ojo Campus.

v) On submission of the hard copy and the bank teller, candidate will be given a receipt of payment.

vi) The receipt of payment and acknowledgement card admit candidate into the examination hall.
