

## SPECIAL BULLETIN

### I. RE-OPENING OF STUDENT REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEES

The Vice Chancellor, Professor Lateef Akanni Hussain, at a special meeting with all Deans and Heads of Departments on problems relating to the registration of students held on Tuesday, 15<sup>th</sup> January, 2008, DIRECTED that registration and payment of School Fees be re-opened with effect from **Tuesday, 15<sup>th</sup> January, 2008**, till **Friday, 29<sup>th</sup> February, 2008**.

This is to give room for students of the University, who have not been able to pay their school fees or complete their registration on line.

Affected students are advised to NOTE that NO further extension will be granted after this moratorium.

Also, ALL returning students who are indebted to the University, are ADVISED to pay their school fees for the 2007/2008 academic session, as previously scheduled vide the Official bulletin, INFO/PR/LASU/392 dated 23<sup>rd</sup> October, 2007, on the approved instalmental payment of tuition fees of:

- **RETURNING STUDENTS:** A **first instalment of fifteen thousand (N15,000:00) naira**, during the first semester and a **second instalment of ten thousand (N10,000) naira** during the second semester of 2007/2008 academic session.
- **FRESH STUDENTS:** A **first instalment of twenty thousand (N20,000.00) naria** during the first semester and a second instalment **of fifteen thousand (N15,000.00) naira**, during the second semester.

ALL students who have outstanding fees for the 2005/2006 academic session are **STRONGLY ADVISED** to pay **WITH IMMEDIATE EFFECT**.

Final year students who are indebted to the University shall not be cleared or mobilised for the National Youth Service Corps (N.Y.S.C).
