Graduands should be properly robed and are advised to conform to the colour prescribed for their respective Faculties.

9. **RETURN/LOSS/DAMAGE OF ACADEMIC ATTIRE**

Academic attire collected, should be returned immediately, after each ceremony OR at the latest by Monday, 11th February, 2008. Thereafter, the refundable fee of **two thousand naira [N2,000]**, shall be returned to the Graduand at the Bursary, on presentation of clearance obtained, at their respective Faculties. Any Graduand, who holds on to the Academic Attire beyond Monday, 11th February, 2008, shall be liable to a fine of **five Hundred naira [N500]**, for each day of default. Also, any graduand who loses, OR damages the Academic Attire, shall pay ten thousand, three hundred naira [**N10, 300**] only, as a replacement fee.

10. **COLLECTION OF CERTIFICATES**

Graduands who have met all the stipulated conditionalities of Certificates collection are **ADVISED** to collect their certificates immediately after the Ceremony, in the respective Faculty Offices **OR** the Postgraduate School, as the case may be.
