

RECOMMENDATIONS BY THE LASU SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY AND INITIATIVE

At its meeting of Monday, August 2, 2010, the Management Committee of Lagos State University **considered and approved the recommendations of the LASU Social Responsibility and Initiative Committee [SRIC] and decided** as follows:

(1) Security Issues on the University Campus

(i) Busy LASU Campus Roads

That more tallies in different colours be produced to control the traffic. [**white colour tallies for staff members, red for the students** and blue for others].

(ii) Checking of Booths of Vehicles in and out of the Campus

The Security Personnel should start checking the booths of vehicles moving in and out of the University, with no **exception, to prevent loss of University property.**

(iii) Illegal Hawkers and Traders on the Campus

The Space Allocation Committee **should document the traders that are legally on ground** to enable the Security Unit handle the illegal hawkers.

The **Security Unit is empowered to seize the wares of illegal traders** especially those that always converge at the Faculty of Arts premises to display their wares.

(iv) Encroachment of Vehicle Owners and Auto Mechanics on LASU Fence areas along Okokomaiko / PPL

The University Authorities should report the encroachment to the Lagos State Government.

(2) Beautification of the University Frontage areas by the Parks and Gardens Unit

The Parks and Gardens Unit should carry out the beautification of the University frontages towards Iba junction to prevent public encroachment.

(3) **Introduction of Logbooks for Cleaning Contractors in the various offices of the University**

- (i) Management approved the use of logbooks for the daily attendance of the cleaning contractors in the various offices to monitor their attendance and performance.
- (ii) Furthermore, **the contract of the professional cleaners should be reviewed bi-annually.**

(4) **Provision of a new Staff Club for the University**

Management noted that a new Staff Club had been incorporated in the proposal for the hosting/bidding for the NUGA Games in 2014, submitted to the Lagos State Government.

(5) **Request for Fund to conduct a One-Day Workshop for Fish Farmers in the immediate LASU Community**

Management approved the sum of **five hundred and eighty thousand, five hundred naira (N580,500.00)** only, to conduct a One-Day Workshop for Fish Farmers in the immediate LASU Community.

(6) **Increase in the Servicing Fund of the Weed Clearing Inspection Team**

The **Weed Clearing Inspection Team fund allowance** was increased to twelve thousand naira (**₦12,000.00**) only annually.

(7) **Request for Approval to Release Memorandum in the University Official Bulletin**

Management approved the publication of the Memorandum on the Award for Outstanding Performance to Academic and Administrative Staff in the University Official Bulletin.
