LAGOS STATE UNIVERSITY MATRICULATES FRESH MEN

The newly admitted full time undergraduate students of Lagos State University (LASU) for the **2010/2011 Academic Session** were matriculated on **Monday, June 6, 2011** at the MBA Auditorium, Ojo, Lagos.

In her address, the Acting Vice Chancellor, Professor Ibiyemi I. **Olatunji-Bello** charged the freshers not to rest on their oars as they still have greater challenges and tasks ahead of them. She urged the lucky students to pay serious attention to their studies in order to maintain a good standing in their academic pursuit.

Professor **Olatunji-Bello** reiterated the University's commitment to rewarding students with outstanding performance through the University's scholarship award scheme, such students must obtain a minimum of 4.0 CGPA in the sessional examination results and subsequently maintain a CGPA of 3.5 to benefit from the award scheme.

The Acting Vice Chancellor stated that the Information and Communication Technology Centre of Lagos State University has been upgraded to assist students during registration exercise and in the release of results online.

Professor **Olatunji-Bello** called on parents and guardians to join hands with the University Authority in nurturing the minds of our young fresh intakes for a **brilliant, better** and **rewarding future**, so that they can remain on the path of academic excellence.

She warned the new intakes to stay clear of cultism, uncouth behaviour and indecent dressing, adding that the penalty for cultism is **outright expulsion**.

"Students are encouraged to get involved in sporting activities and make use of the available sporting facilities provided at the University Sports Centre", she reiterated.

The Acting Vice Chancellor used the occasion to thank the Governor and the Visitor to the University, Mr. Babatunde Raji **Fashola**, SAN for his determination to improve the quality of education as well as solving the infrastructural challenges facing LASU by committing a large sum of money to turn around the fortunes of the state's only University.

The Acting Vice Chancellor finally appealed to parents, guardians and other stake holders of the University to donate buildings and equipment to boost the image of the institution.

The matriculating students took the traditional oath of allegiance, pledged good conduct, while selected students from each Faculty signed the Matriculation Register.

A total of **three thousand, one hundred and twenty-seven (3,127) students were cleared for matriculation** out of the **four thousand, three hundred and eleven (4,311) candidates offered admission** during the screening exercise which was **transparent and based on merit**.

Faculty of Management Sciences had the highest number of matriculating students with **one thousand and eight (1,008) freshmen**, while the School of Transport had **thirty-one (31) students**. Others are, Faculties of Arts: **471**, Social Sciences: **275**, Science: **387**, Education: **496**, Law: **143**, School of Communication: **185**, College of Medicine: **55** and Engineering: **76**.
