

SENATE EXTENDS VERIFICATION EXERCISE ON THE IRREGULAR DIRECT ENTRY INTO PART-TIME DEGREE PROGRAMMES

Senate at its Statutory Meeting of Thursday, November 27, 2008 decided to extend the verification exercise of the irregular direct entry into part-time degree programmes for another four **(4) months i.e. (December 2008 – March 2009)**, after which defaulting students will forfeit their studentship of the University.

The decision was taken after Senate had noted that:

- (i) Only one hundred and four (104) students showed up for the second phase of the verification exercise while
- (ii) Two hundred and sixty-six (266) students **failed to appear** for the second phase of the verification exercise.
