

DECISION EXTRACT ON APPLICATIONS OF STAFF MEMBERS FOR THE VARIOUS ETF INTERVENTION PROGRAMMES

The ETF Project Committee at its meeting held on 21st September, 2011 while considering applications of staff members for the various ETF Intervention Programmes **noted** that:

- The various ETF Intervention Programmes that are individual based are:
 - i. Academic Programmes (MSc & PhD)
 - ii. Conference Attendance
 - iii. Research
- That some staff members submitted applications for the three if not two of the programmes.
- The estimated costs for some of these applications are outrageous.

The Committee, after an extensive deliberation **decided** that:

1. A staff member should only benefit from one (1) of the ETF Intervention Programmes, in order for the fund to go round as many as possible members of staff.
2. Research should be College, School, Faculty and Department based, not individual based, and priorities would be given to Medicine, Science and Engineering related research proposals that are also considered beneficial to the University Community.
3. Members of staff wishing to benefit from the ETF Intervention Fund for their various programmes are therefore advised to prioritize their request/application with all the necessary supporting documentary evidence.
