1. To consider Economic Empowerment Programme (EEP) for indigent students.
2. To disseminate Sexuality Informative Programme (SIP) on the following:
 - (a) Sexuality Education Programme for fresh students in the University.
 - (b) Sexuality Education Programme for Primary and Secondary students in Lagos State.
 - (c) Electronic Media programme on what parents and wards should know about sexuality education.
 - (d) Developing an HIV/AIDS workplace policy for the University, with all its component needs for students and staff welfare.
3. To submit proposal on the beautification of major roads within the University Campus.
4. To propose awards for outstanding performance to Academic and Administrative staff.
5. To propose free training to local farmers in the immediate LASU Community to improve farm techniques (especially in fisheries).
6. To suggest recreational facilities for staff and students.

7. To submit proposal on partnership between LASU and local landlords in relation to student accommodation and welfare:
 - (a) to help standardize accommodation offered to students;
 - (b) to help in monitoring student activities even outside of the University Campus;
 - (c) to help improve overall discipline amongst the student populace, etc.
 - (d) to encourage more developers to build standard accommodation for students within the local vicinity of the University.

The Committee is to submit a quarterly report to the Vice Chancellor.
